

pom pom craft project

Lamb

by little oak sanctuary

Materials and tools:

White acrylic wool
Black acrylic wool
Black felt
Stick on eyes
Beads
Pencil
Scissors
Cardboard

Instructions:

Step 1 - Draw and cut out two circles from cardboard with a hole in the centre. The size of your circles will be the size of the sheep's body

Step 2 - Wind the white wool around the card until you can no longer see the hole in the centre

Step 3 - Using scissors, cut the wool on the edge of the circles

Step 4 - Tie a long strand of white or black wool (depending on the colour of your beads) between the two cardboard circles. Knot tightly a couple of times

Step 4 - Tear or cut the cardboard circles to remove them. Now you can fluff up your pom pom to shape

Step 5 - Thread 4 or 5 beads onto each tied strand and thread the beads on

Step 6 - Cut the face from felt and stick on the eyes

Step 7 - Using a small amount of glue, place the face on your pom pom

OPTIONS - If you would like to hang your sheep up, tie another piece of white 'wool' between the 2 cardboard circles and tie to make a loop
